Trello is an easy-to-use tool for the occasional project manager. This 3h30 hands-on workshop will enable you to build a functional project management chart. Tested and improved as a group, this chart will be directly operational in your practice.

1 Building your Trello board

- Represent the company's processes in the table.
- Ensure a shared project vision with Trello.
- Using Trello as a roadmap.
- Define project progress measurement.

Hands-on work

Each participant creates his or her own Trello board, integrating the project processes and methods specific to his or her organization. They define objectives, milestones and progress measurements.

2 Bringing the project to life with Trello

- Organize Trello cards: schedule individual and team tasks.
- Facilitate collaborators' experience of the project: card templates, automations, and action buttons.
- Consolidate basic Trello best practices.

Hands-on work

Workshop: sharing and cross-use of tables. Feedback and recommendations for improvement: fluidity and legibility of scheduling, standardization of processes with templates, automation and action buttons. Definition of a charter of best practices.

TEACHING AIDS AND TECHNICAL RESOURCES

- The main teaching aids and instructional methods used in the training are audiovisual aids, documentation and course material, hands-on application exercises and corrected exercises for practical training courses, case studies and coverage of real cases for training seminars.
- At the end of each course or seminar, ORSYS provides participants with a course evaluation questionnaire that is analysed by our instructional teams.
- A check-in sheet for each half-day of attendance is provided at the end of the training, along with a course completion certificate if the trainee attended the entire session.
