2 Managing layers and photo editing tools

- Create layers to organize image elements.
- Use masks to modify the transparency or content of a specific area of the image.
- Use red-eye correction, cloning, object removal, content filling and brush tools.
- Use filters to add artistic effects.

Hands-on work

Create layers to organize elements and use correction tools to remove imperfections.

3 Using selection and cropping tools

- Use selection tools to select specific areas of an image.
- Use cropping tools to adjust image dimensions.

Hands-on work

Select an image and crop it to improve composition.

4 Using drawing tools to create illustrations

- Use drawing tools to create shapes.
- Use paint tools to add color.
- Use layers to organize elements.

Hands-on work

Create shapes, add color and organize elements on separate layers.

5 Image settings

- Use adjustments to modify brightness, contrast, saturation, sharpness, color temperature, etc.
- Use curves to adjust brightness and contrast more precisely.
- Use filters to modify image appearance.
- Import image files into Affinity Photo.
- Export image files in various formats.

Hands-on work

Modify parameters using adjustment tools.

TEACHING AIDS AND TECHNICAL RESOURCES

- The main teaching aids and instructional methods used in the training are audiovisual aids, documentation and course material, hands-on application exercises and corrected exercises for practical training courses, case studies and coverage of real cases for training seminars.

- Create text blocks.
- Modification of text parameters.
