The experts leading the training are specialists in the covered subjects. 1 Analyze team dynamics

- Master the basic principles of group dynamics.
- Identify the fundamental conditions for teamwork.
- Analyze team collaboration (standards, coordination, communication).
- Develop your team's collective intelligence.

Group discussion

Analysis of the main difficulties encountered by managers in the rest of the group. Feedback and modeling of best practices.

2 Learn to position yourself as a leader

- Strengthen team cohesion.
- Understand the main differences between a leader and a chef.
- Define the essential components of leadership.
- Assert yourself as a leader through the 5 fundamental functions of leadership.

Role-playing

Simulation of speaking in front of a team, with progressive integration of disruptive elements. Group debriefing on observed behaviors.

3 Experience and analyze the collaborative process

- Deconstruct representations of the collaborative phenomenon.
- Learn to work together using the mechanics of an escape game.
- Analyze factors favoring and hindering collaboration.

Exercise

Typical exercises "escape game": the box and the symbol race.

4 Unleash your team's collective intelligence

- Identify the conditions required for collective intelligence to emerge.
- Acting on the manager's levers: instilling a common culture, developing the ability to speak out.
- Make decisions based on group input.

Exercise

Creation of a personal action plan on measures to promote collaborative teamwork.
