HERMES 2022 is a project management approach that incorporates the latest developments in project management, and stands out for its approach to integrating agility into a well-structured context. The design is based on results, activities and roles, which form a coherent module to deal with a particular aspect of the project, such as purchasing, product or service development, or project management. Alternating theory and exercises, this training course prepares participants for the HERMES 2022 foundation certification.

Certification

Take the HERMES 2022 certification in French, online via the TÜV Süd platform and without any support admitted. The exam consists of a 40-question MCQ. The exam lasts a maximum of 1 hour, and certification is obtained if the candidate obtains at least 24 correct answers (60%).
