2 Talking in pictures

- Associating a word with an image has a double effect: meaning and appeal.
- Make it easier to memorize pictorial messages.
- Master the text-image relationship.
- Develop your ideas in images.
- Making numbers talk: the impact of infographics.
- Playing with concept effects: PowerPoint, Pecha Kucha.
- What to say with emoticons: the place of emotion.
- Adopt a creative posture to express yourself: association, analogy.

3 Optimizing photo quality

- What images for what communication?
- Identify and select images by their symbolism: color, visual...
- Choose the right formats and resolutions for your media.
- Work on framing.
- Know the specificities of visuals on the Internet.
- Know how to retouch your visuals.
- Use filters.
- Strive for consistency in the graphic charter.

4 Respect rights to use and share images

- Understand copyright legislation: image creation, retouching, use, sharing...
- Know the specificities of using visuals on the Internet.
- An overview of image banks and how they work.

In sub-groups, draw up a checklist of checks to be carried out before using an image.
