You'll create non-linear video edits with Final Cut Pro. You'll learn how to unshoot, edit shots, adjust durations and set up pre-edits. You'll also learn how to mix tracks, create transitions and animation effects, and apply filters.

- Standards and formats: SD and HD codecs, video and audio formats.
- Definitions and main rules of video editing.

- Effects: apply and customize effects.
- Basic sound settings: volume, split-edit and time modulation.

5 Advanced functions

- The use of markers.
- Resynchronization tools (accelerated and slowed).
- Key-frame animation.
- Colorimetry and calibration.

- Export formats.
- Export interface management.
- Project duplication.
- Project archiving.

Export a project to any format.
