- Using a Cluster Distributed Resource Scheduler.
- VMware High Availability (HA) cluster management.

- VM replication with vSphere Replication.
- VM recovery (on schedule or disaster recovery).

Manage software replication of virtual machines.

6 Virtual infrastructure upgrade

- Virtual infrastructure upgrade.
- ESXi update management with VMware Update Manager.

Hands-on work

Manage virtual infrastructure updates with Update Manager.
