With this course, you develop your product discovery and validation skills to optimize value creation. As a result, you'll be better prepared to design the right features and fine-tune your products to real market needs.

- 3 Analyze feedback to identify satisfaction gaps
- 4 Prioritize the hypotheses to be validated according to their impact
- 5 Formulate a clear hypothesis to be validated or invalidated
- 6 Use the right data to test the hypothesis
- 7 Analyze experimental results
- 8 Compare your decisions with those of other team members
- 9 Adopt an evidence-based approach with stakeholders
