

Course : Professional Scrum Master - Advanced (PSM-A)

Scrum.org Official Training

This course is an advanced class designed to support Scrum Masters in their professional development. It experiments with the postures of the effective Scrum Master, and goes further in the service provided to developers, the product owner and the organization.

Teaching objectives

At the end of the training, the participant will be able to:

- ✓ Relier le cadre Scrum, les principes et les valeurs et la façon dont ils aident à prendre des décisions
- ✓ Explorer les outils, pratiques, et postures d'un Scrum Master efficace
- ✓ Identifier comment aider les développeurs et le product owner à développer leur efficacité

- ✓ Collect tips and techniques to help the organization work better with Scrum teams

Certification

Participants in the Professional Scrum Master - Advanced course will receive a password to take the PSM-A certification. Recognized by the industry, Scrum.org certifications are rigorous assessments requiring a minimum score of 85%. Participants who have made a first attempt within 14 days of the training are entitled to a second chance. Participation in the training course entitles participants to 14 PDU credits from PMI.

- Measuring results. Measuring deliverables. Measurement strategies and EBM.
- Being a change agent in a complex environment. Sharing tips and tricks.
