1 Creating and configuring management clusters

- Create a vSphere cluster for management workloads.
- Enable vSphere cluster features to improve VM resources and availability.
- Use standard virtual switches to create a cluster network.
- Select the appropriate vSphere storage types to meet your requirements.
- Configure iSCSI storage.
- Configure VMFS and NFS databases.
- Recognize when to configure ESXi NTP and PTP support.
- Recognize ESXi user account best practices.
- Configure ESXi host parameters.
- Use vSphere configuration profiles to maintain consistent ESXi host configurations.

2 Creating and configuring production clusters

- Use the cluster quick start guide to create a vSAN-enabled cluster.
- Configure advanced vSphere HA settings.
- Configurer le fournisseur d'identité vCenter.
- Assign specific roles and authorizations to ADFS (Active Directory Federation Services) users.
- Configure enhanced vMotion compatibility on a cluster and a virtual machine.
- Migrate between vCenter Servers.
- Use content libraries to share virtual machine models between sites.
- Manage VM and ESXi host resources using resource pools, shares and vSphere DRS rules.

3 vSphere troubleshooting and configuration backup

- Solve ESXi connectivity problems.
- Solve ESXi storage problems.
- Solve vSphere cluster problems.
- Solve PowerCLI-related problems.
- Generate vCenter and ESXi log bundles.
- Save vCenter.
- Create a vCenter profile to standardize configurations in the environment.

- Solve upgrade blocking problems.
- Increase logging levels on vCenter.
- Set up a VMware Tools shared repository.
- vCenter upgrade.
- ESXi upgrade.
- Upgrade VMware tools.
- Upgrade hardware compatibility of virtual machines.

5 vSphere Security

- Configure a key management server.
- Encrypt virtual machines using vSphere virtual machine encryption.
- Secure VMs in transit with encrypted vSphere vMotion.
- Identify and implement different ESXi CPU scheduler options.
- Apply security enhancement instructions to ESXi hosts.
- Replace vCenter certificates with trusted certificates signed by a certification authority.
- Reconfigure the primary network identifier of a vCenter instance.
