6 Design and customize a Joomla! template with Gantry 5

- Install and customize Gantry 5.
- Default style settings: template "base outline".
- Understanding the structure of a template: the layout.
- Create and customize module positions.
- Creation of Joomla! page templates and assembly of an authentication page for an intranet/extranet site.
- Introduction to the concept of Gantry 5 particles.
- Menu and hyper menu management.
- Setting up the customization style sheet.
- CSS code compiler: the Sass language in Gantry 5.
- Add a font.

- Template design and positioning of the Joomla! template.

- Creation and customization of the template by integrating CSS code into the style sheet.
