Drupal is a free, open-source content management system. You will learn how to create, manage and administer the content of a site built with the current version of Drupal. You'll see how to organize editorial content, populate the site and offer additional functionalities via extensions.

- Install and configure a module.
- Module field: building your own content type.
- views module: customize content display.
- Other useful modules (CKEditor, entity reference, referencing...).

Hands-on work

Install and use a new module (field, views...).

7 Administering a Drupal site

- Administrator tasks. Dashboard.
- Access management: users, roles, permissions.
- Save and restore the site.
- Site production, cloning and updating.
- Automate tasks (content publication, etc.).
